Art activity Fun with flour Home Learning


Snowflake

- Tape some double sided tape onto your black paper or spread/ pour some glue in a snowflake shape.
- Have fun pulling the backing paper off the strips. Make sure you pull each backing strip off before adding the next one!
- Use your fingers or a sieve to sprinkle the flour over the tape.
 Why not sing a snow song while doing this?
- Shake the paper to reveal your lovely snowflake.

Materials needed:

Flour (any type), double sided tape or glue, black paper, natural materials such as-twigs, leaves, pine branches, toy animals, vegetable oil (or any other), spoon, bowl, cup, sieve (optional)







Flour silhouettes

- Choose some objects and lay them on your black paper.
- Sprinkle the flour as you did with your snowflake.
- Lift the objects to reveal the silhouettes.
 Can you match the object to the silhouette?

Snow dough

- Scoop and pour the flour into the centre of a large tub or tray.
- Create a crater in the middle of the flour.
- Pour the oil into the crater.
- Gently mix it all together.
- Enjoy mixing and learning about the properties of the dough as it is, or add small silicone bowls, spoons, or measuring cups to make small structures like hills.
- Why not make a winter scene by adding pine branches for trees and some toy animals?
