Our Learning Environment

- Fully embed our new Vision Values and Aims across the school.
- Increase effective use of iPads and digital technology to support learning.
- Evaluate learning environments across the school and ensure they are of a consistently high quality.
- Identify further opportunities to take learning outdoors.
- Review and improve systems for recording pupil achievements and interests to ensure pupil targets and learning experiences are pupil centred and appropriately differentiated.
- Provide ongoing staff training in Gentle Teaching to ensure a consistent, appropriate and supportive learning environment for all pupils.

Our Curriculum

- Develop and roll out our Wider Achievement policy and strategy, 'The Oaklands Promise'.
- Review and improve our forward planning approach and topic planners to ensure appropriate curriculum breadth and coverage.
- Trial additional curriculum focus weeks.
- Expand the existing pupil tracking document to track Literacy and Numeracy in addition to the Foundation Milestones.
- Investigate ways to raise the profile of Learning for Sustainability (LfS) and more fully embed it in all areas of the curriculum.
- Expand our in-house Duke of Edinburgh provision by training an additional Expedition supervisor and assessor.

- Share Vision Values and Aims with families and make them more visible across all platforms including website, social media, events and home/school communication.
- Maintain and increase our community partnerships including volunteers, local businesses and outside organisations.
